Method of the Study : For this Present study Researcher has used Experimental Research Method.

Research Design : Pre-Experimental Research – Single Group Design –Pre –test and Post-test Design has used.

Population and Sampling: Purposive sampling method was adopted for the present study.

Population : All the Teacher-trainees from University of Pune were the population for the present study.

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Sample: 80 students from Abhinav College of Education, Ambegaon (Bk.), Pune were selected as a sample by using purposive sampling method-Non-probability sampling method was used.

Tools for Data Collection : 1.) Pre achievement Test to test the knowledge about Event Management Skills of B.Ed. Teacher-trainees.

2.) Post achievement Test to find out the achievement of B.Ed. Teacher-trainees after conduction of Programme.

Statistical Tools: Researcher has made use of Mean, Standard Deviation and Co-efficient of co-relation from descriptive statistics. For testing the hypothesis the Researcher has made use of t-test from inferential statistics along with the descriptive statistics.

Procedure of Research:

Pre-test - to test the knowledge about

Programme implementation

- 10 days (One & Half hr.) each day on Event Management Skill Development Activity. 02 Lectures and 08 Activities

Post –test to measure the improvement in Knowledge about Event Management Skills


Data Analysis, Interpretation of Data and Conclusion
