3. Hard Work:


currently, so numerous scholars want to cheat and cut corners in their studies, because they're lazy and don't place any value on hard word. This thinking must change.

Compassion is defined as being sensitive to the requirements of people. However, there would be less homeless, hunger, If there were further compassion in the world.


7. Remission
